Advance Tapes launches unique and improved Premier Closure Plate Tape

Any fumes, such as carbon monoxide, escaping from the back of the gas fire can be deadly. And as you can't smell, see or taste it, it makes it even more important to use the PRS10 approved product, tested and used by Corgi registered gas installers since its introduction.

"We are confident that our improved tape outperforms any other tape in the market place for this application", says Technical Project Manager Alan Herringshaw. "Our tape has excellent adhesion, is easier to apply to uneven surfaces than ever and our unique Surefire® Adhesive means that our tape can resist temperatures of over 100°C and bakes on once it reaches 110°C, ensuring an airtight seal. Any problem can be identified immediately when the fire is serviced, saving time and potentially lives."
